As a Lantern Health member, you have access to the following medical services, with many covered as part of your monthly membership fee, unless otherwise indicated

Direct Access

Through the secure Spruce Health app you have 24/7, access to your physician and care team for your unique needs, including the following:

- » **Schedule an appointment**
- » **Ask your care team any question** about your health
- » **Check in about a new or ongoing health issue**
- » **Request a prescription refill**
- » **Connect with your provider for video visits**
- » **Complete a Spruce Visit**, a type of virtual visit with a series of questions, and receive treatment for common medical issues, including allergies, cold and flu, headache, pink eye, rash, sore throat, & UTI

Visits

Unlimited visits with any provider (physician, nurse, health coach, medical assistant) of the Lantern Health team at no charge or copay to Member.

Visits can be in-office or virtual via text, phone, or video.

Point-of-Care Lab Tests

Unlimited of the following point-of-care lab tests as directed by provider at no added cost:

- » **Glucose test strip (blood sugar)**
- » **Rapid influenza**
- » **Rapid strep**
- » **Urinalysis**
- » **Urine pregnancy test**

Included Procedures

Unlimited of the following in-office procedures as directed by provider at no added cost.

- » Callus shaving/removal
- » Cryotherapy/freezing of lesions
- » Ear lavage
- » EKG
- » Fluorescein eye exam
- » Hearing screening
- » Incision and drainage
- » IUD/Nexplanon insertion/removal (not including device)
- » Nail avulsion/removal
- » PAP Smear with or without HPV testing (1 per year if uninsured)
- » Pulmonary function testing
- » Simple wound cleaning and repair, including basic suturing
- » Uncomplicated skin tag or skin lesion removal (not including biopsy)

Non-Included Procedures

Access to the following in-office procedures as directed by provider with transparent pricing:

- » Skin biopsy: \$50
- » Vasectomy: \$350

Care Coordination and Referrals.

Coordination and guidance for any health care services required outside of the practice, including specialist referrals and support for Members who are hospitalized or require surgery.

Advocacy and guidance for Member in finding high-quality, low-cost options for any health care services required outside of the practice where applicable.

Vaccinations

Administration of vaccinations as recommended by the CDC with **coverage through most insurance plans, including pediatric vaccinations**. Confirmation of coverage provided in advance of visit when possible, and **wholesale cash prices** are also available.

Medications

Our members have access to various **common over-the counter medications** at Lantern sold at cost.

Our members have **access to over 300 prescription medications** at wholesale pricing through our local, innovative partner Sona Pharmacy, with detailed pricing as provided on the document "Sona + Lantern Medication Pricing".

Imaging

Basic x-rays through our imaging partner Open MRI, not including mammograms or DEXA scans, are available for **\$100 per x-ray**. We also maintain **cash pricing for CT scans, MRIs, and ultrasound**.

Specialist E-Consultation

We have access to **specialist e-consultation on behalf of our clients** through our partner Thea Health.
